The San Diego County Assessor/Recorder/County Clerk's office will be open on Valentine's Day, Wednesday, February 14<sup>th</sup> to issue marriage licenses and perform ceremonies! The San Diego County Assessor/Recorder/County Clerk, Ernie Dronenburg, would like to remind couples wishing to "tie the knot" or renew their wedding vows that appointments are filling quickly.

"We are excited to offer walk-in services for Valentine's Day and don't want couples to miss their chance at a Valentine's Day wedding," said Ernie. "Call right now so we can help you plan this special day."

The downtown office located at 1600 Pacific Highway, Suite 273, will be open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. for marriage licenses and ceremony appointments. Ceremonies can be done at our Waterfront Park, alongside the historical County Administration Center or inside one of our ceremony rooms overlooking the beautiful San Diego Bay.

Couples may "walk-in" at our downtown location only. License and Ceremony appointments are encouraged at our downtown location, but are required in our Chula Vista, San Marcos, and El Cajon locations.

Appointments can be made by calling (619) 237-0502. The cost of a non-confidential marriage license is \$70.00. If the couple would like their ceremony to be performed by one of our wonderful County staff, the cost is an additional \$88.00.
